Harry Gallis: TOS and Orchids in NC and SC Past, Present and Future January 9, 2017, 7:30 PM

Dr. Harry Gallis, a native of Athens, GA, is a graduate of Princeton University and Duke University School of Medicine and has a specialty in Internal Medicine and Infectious Diseases. He retired in 2008 and is continuing this work as a consultant.

Harry began growing orchids in 1980 and currently has about 380 plants, of which his favorites are Cattleyas, Phalaenopsis and Dendrobiums. His many other hobbies include gardening, cooking and golf, and he enjoys Duke basketball games. Harry and his wife, Susie, have two children and two granddaughters.

Initially, Harry joined the American Orchid Society's Education Committee. Then he became Chair of the Carolinas Judging Center and later a member of the AOS Governance and Publications Committees. Harry has served on the boards of a variety of regional organizations. He is a lifetime member of the Triangle Orchid Society and is currently President. Over the years, he has belonged to many of the NC orchid societies.

Harry's plants have received 54 AOS awards. He has raised his own hybrids, including one named for his wife, *Slc.* Susie's Valentine. Two he named for his granddaughters have received awards: *Rlc.* Lisa Taylor Gallis 'Taylor' HCC/AOS and *Dendrobium* Linc's Jewel 'Savannah Hope' HCC/AOS. Harry's daughter, Sara Gallis, has recently become an orchid enthusiast and works at The Orchid Trail in Morrisville, NC.






